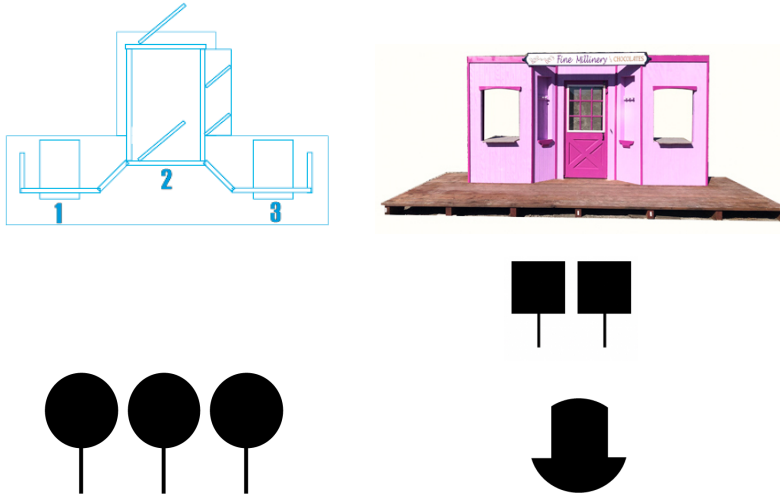


Bay 12 - Rose and Bev's Fine Millinery and Chocolates - Scenario B



STAGING: 10 rifle, 10 pistol, 2 plus shotgun, three shooting positions; Position 1 is at left window, Position 2 is at front doorway, and Position 3 is at right window. Rifle and shotgun are staged in gun rack on either side of doorway.

NOTE: The three round diamond targets are for pistol at Position 1. The hat target opens the back door at end of hallway to reveal the two square rifle targets at Position 2. The two round targets at Position 3 are for shotgun – the top round one opens the front door of Rose and Bev's Fine Millinery and Chocolates.

START: Starting at Position 1 hands on hips.

SHOOTER INDICATES READY BY SINGING: "Where's the chocolates?"

AT THE BEEP: Engage the three pistol targets with three shots each and the 10th shot on the center target. With pistols made safe retrieve shotgun from the rack and move to Position 3 to engage the top round target until the door opens, and then the bottom target until you think it's down. Make shot safe in rack and retrieve the rifle. Stand in front doorway and engage the hat target to open the back door. When you see the two square targets alternately engage them with 10 rounds. When you are done, pick up your chocolates at the unloading table (or from your kitchen!).
